

INTERNATIONAL DIMENSION OF OUR HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

Prépa EC – (Prépa) DCG – BTS – Licence & Master

Being open to the world and to others is one of the main foundations of Grandchamp. This openness is visible in the Lycee as well as in Higher Education. Here is an overview of what Grandchamp has to offer:

1. *Programmes with a strong international dimension :*

a. BTS CI: (corresponds to a Higher National Diploma in International Trade)

The different subject matters prepare you for a career in international trade. Besides, the compulsory 2-month-long work placement abroad widens your experience. This internationalization is further fulfilled through the preparation for the TOEIC exams and a series of lectures by professional experts in international trade. In this context, the CNCCEF organises a competition in which our students take an active part.

b. Prépa DCG (Diploma in Accounting – Management) & Bachelor en Gestion, Finance et Ethique (Management – Finance & Ethics):

The Prepa DCG (a 3-year-degree in accounting and management) gives young people the opportunity to acquire strong foreign language skills together with a detailed knowledge of foreign civilizations. This prepares students for their future international mobility in their trade school. This mobility will translate into academic exchanges, and / or work placement all over the world.

Grandchamp enables students to give an international dimension to this double degree - consisting of the prépa DCG & Bachelor GF&E (= Bachelor in Management, Finance & Ethics). If both work placements (of 4 and 8 weeks) are done abroad, students are awarded an additional international component to their double degree.

c. Prépa EC

This demanding degree typically prepares students to sit admission exams for the Grandes Ecoles de Commerce.

The prepa EC (3 year degree in Economics – with economic, scientific or technological option) allows students to acquire excellent foreign language skills together with a detailed knowledge of foreign civilizations, so that they are well prepared for their future international mobility in their trade school. This mobility will translate into academic exchanges, and or work placements in Europe, Asia or North & South America.

Last year, 50 of our students were accepted in the three top schools in France. Almost all of them were admitted in the top ten. Here are their direct links, to visualize the international prospects:



2. Work placements abroad :

a. BTS CI

Compulsory two-month-internship abroad (in an English speaking country or any other country whose language you have studied).

ERASMUS + grants can be obtained, as Grandchamp has the new Erasmus Charter for the period 2014-2020



b. BTS AM

A four-week-placement, preferably abroad, under the framework of international mobility, subsidized by the region Ile de France.

c. Prépa DCG

Two work placements, at the end of your first and second years, which you are strongly encouraged to do abroad.

3. Strong focus on language learning :

- a. Preparation for globally recognized exams : HSK (Chinese) TOEIC & Bulats (English)

- b. Many hours taught in the two foreign languages you have chosen (English and Spanish or German or Chinese)
- c. Small groups of students for language classes in prepa
- d. Many different languages taught in Prépa (First foreign language : English, German – Second foreign language : English, German, Arab, Spanish, Russian, Italian, Chinese – which can be presented as a first foreign language at the exam, if the student wishes to do so)

4. Humanitarian missions and cultural trips :

Many students go on a humanitarian mission abroad during the summer, between their first and second year. Grandchamp assists the students in the planning of their project.



Some years, first year students of Prépa EC go on a cultural trip to Bristol, where they can follow intensive English classes targeting their specific needs. In the afternoons, they also take part in a rich and varied cultural programme.



5. Further studies abroad:
